REFLECTION

Pentecost saw the birth of a new community, the new People of God. Today then is the day the apostles left the upper room where they had been hiding for fear of the Iews and went out fearlessly to preach the gospel. Today the Church is born. He comes to us not just as individuals but as a community, the Church. If you want to be free you must let yourselves be guided not by the Spirit of selfindulgence but by the Spirit of God. They make life miserable and make slaves of us. Besides, those who live like this do not belong in the Kingdom of God. But consider the legacy the Spirit brings: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. These are beautiful things. They make life worthwhile, and those who live like this are free agents. They already belong to the Kingdom of God, but what they enjoy now is only a foretaste of the joys to come. Spirit of the Living God, fall afresh on me.
